

Regional Planning Commission Complete Streets Advisory Committee

Mission:

The mission of the Complete Streets Advisory Committee is to address projects and policies that impact bicycle, pedestrian and transit users through input from citizen representatives of the RPC's seven parish metropolitan region.

Role:

The Regional Planning Commission Complete Streets Advisory Committee will make recommendations to the RPC staff and Technical Advisory Committee about planning and project priorities, potential concerns and desired accommodations for roadways under RPC purview; those of regional significance on the Federal-Aid or State network. The Technical Advisory Committee and RPC staff will review recommendations for viability and technical concerns using the adopted planning process. The CSAC will provide insights and information to ultimately inform planning documents and Transportation Policy Board decision making. At this time the CSAC is intended to advance non-motorized considerations in the Regional Planning Commission process.

Job Description:

Committee members will represent their Parishes, bringing their individual experiences and knowledge of their communities to the Committee's efforts. This will help ensure that the Committee has local perspectives in identifying the active transportation needs and problems in our communities. Additionally, Committee members will serve as citizen liaisons with their communities to raise awareness of Complete Streets, their benefits and how to incorporate Complete Streets into their communities.

Committee members serve two-year terms with quarterly meetings generally held on the third Monday of February, May, August and November. Additionally activities take place between committee members and RPC staff via list serve.
