



Introduction



*New Directions 2025: St. Tammany Parish Comprehensive Plan*

St. Tammany Parish is the fastest growing parish in the state. Often thought of as a bedroom community of New Orleans, St. Tammany Parish appeals to those who enjoy living among the piney woods and scenic waterways typical of the south. Once the northern and southern shores of Lake Pontchartrain were connected by the Lake Pontchartrain Causeway in the 1950s, the population began to grow. This access and the charming allure of St. Tammany has caused the population to grow from 38,643 in 1960 to 191,268 in 2000 (U.S. Bureau of the Census).

Given these growth trends, St. Tammany must confront the challenge of successfully controlling and managing its growth in a way that preserves the character and integrity of the current way of life. Successfully leading St. Tammany Parish into the twenty-first century will take strong leadership and vision and the proven ability to bring people together and get things done. It will also require a lot of long hours and hard work.<sup>1</sup>

A comprehensive plan can be described as a vision of a community's future for physical development and is prepared based upon planning principles. Although it is a physical plan it is also a reflection of social and economic values. The plan is fundamentally a guide to physical development. It is the translation of values into a scheme that describes how, why, when and where to build, rebuild or preserve/conservate land.

A comprehensive plan is long range usually covering 20 to 25 years. An effective plan must express current policies that will shape the future rather than show a rigid image of the future itself. A good plan should inspire us with a vision of what might be and also tell us how to get there. The plan must cover the entire geographic area of St. Tammany Parish as well as all functions that make the parish work. Finally, the plan should be a guide to decision making by the community's elected and appointed officials.

*New Directions 2025 – the St. Tammany Comprehensive Plan* is a multi-year effort consisting of ten plan elements: *Vision, Community Facilities, Critical and Sensitive Areas, Economic Development, Essential Community Design, Housing, Land Use, Natural Hazards, Transportation and Implementation*. Following a December 1998 "orientation" public meeting, the *New Directions 2025 – St. Tammany Parish Comprehensive Plan Vision* element was initiated in early 1999. This community-driven visioning process was specifically designed to define a desired future and to encourage dialogue and interaction among citizens. Following recommendations for approval by the Steering Committee and the Planning Commission, on December 8, 1999, the St. Tammany Parish Council adopted the *Vision* element as the first of the ten-element comprehensive plan.

For each comprehensive plan element the *Vision* element document contains an action plan to achieve the values and goals set by the public. A work program was devised to outline these actions and to translate them into tasks. The New Orleans Regional Planning Commission and the St. Tammany Parish Government approved the work program to be implemented January 2000 through August 2001.

Given limited resources, this work program concentrated on the *Land Use* and *Transportation* elements. Additionally, existing conditions for all other elements were profiled and analyzed during this work program. The detailed preparation of all other plan elements will be addressed in subsequent years.

Set forth by *New Directions 2025 Vision* element and structured by the January 2000 to August 2001 work program, this report includes one volume outlining the conceptual framework for the *Land Use and Transportation* elements, two volumes of working papers that lay the foundation for the conceptual framework and one volume of maps generated throughout the January 2000 to August 2001 work program documenting existing conditions and the conceptual framework. Additionally, all meetings (focus group forums and steering committee) notes are compiled in a compendium volume documenting the discourse during this work program. **VOLUME 1: Land Use and Transportation Plan Elements Conceptual Framework**

Land use concerns itself simply with how the land is utilized, conserved or developed. Transportation consists of the various ways in which people and goods travel from place to place in St. Tammany Parish. Volume 1 provides the conceptual framework for the *Land Use* and *Transportation* elements of *New Directions 2025*. These frameworks relate projected population growth to land use and transportation in terms of alternative scenarios of growth. Volume 1 includes the following:

**VOLUME 2: Land Use and Transportation Elements: Profile and Analysis**

Profiles and analyses of existing conditions for community facilities, critical and sensitive areas, economic development, housing, natural hazards, land use and transportation are addressed in Volume 2. The relationship among these elements greatly depends upon population trends and estimates of the area hence profiles of local, regional, statewide, and global demographics were gathered and analyzed.

*Land Use* is described based on historic and existing patterns, while *Transportation* is addressed by integrating traditional and alternative modes of transportation. Coverage of existing *Community Facilities* concentrates on drainage, schools, utilities, recreation, civic and cultural amenities, government uses, and health and safety accommodations. The *Critical and Sensitive Areas* element is considered essential to making land use and transportation decisions. This consideration is linked to an environmental profile addressing issues related to floodplains, wetlands, and wildlife and timber management areas. *Economic Development* was researched on the basis of commercial and industrial zoning, job growth, workforce skills, and existing economic programs and regulations. *Housing* information provides residential types, densities, values, conditions, regulations, and barriers. *Natural Hazards* are analyzed based on areas prone to natural hazard events and are in need of evacuation routes, and available shelters.

Throughout the January 2000 to August 2001 work program, a series of working papers addressing the profiles and analyses of the above were prepared. These working papers were presented and discussed at focus group forums, steering committee meetings and monthly meetings of the various focus groups. Volume 2 contains the following working papers:

**VOLUME 3: Comprehensive Plan Tools and Techniques**

Volume 3 presents a series of comprehensive planning tools and techniques including the process and use of a Geographic Information System (GIS) for mapping, land conservation tools and techniques, and an overview of landscape and sign ordinances best practices. These best practices were evaluated and citizens of the *Essential Community Design* focus group formed a work group with other focus group members to draft parish wide landscaping, sign and lighting ordinances.

Volume 3 also presents model comprehensive planning legislation organized around structure, plan preparation, procedures for review, adoption and amendment, as well as plan implementation procedures and agreements with other governmental bodies. Additionally, the *Implementation* element has considered a proposal to assess the current and future staffing needs for long term comprehensive planning in St. Tammany Parish.

Finally, Volume 3 contains a series of grant applications prepared during the January 2000 through August 2001 work program. Currently, one grant program is underway – the watershed planning grant under the *Critical and Sensitive Areas* element focus group.








# Map 2a: St. Tammany Parish Municipal Growth (1986-2001)



# Map 2b: St. Tammany Parish Municipal Growth (1986-2001)






# Map 3: St. Tammany Parish Level 1 Land Use





# Map 16: St. Tammany Parish Projected Population Growth Rate by Census Tract, 2000-2025






Map 17: St. Tammany Parish 1990 Median Household Income by Census Tract





# Map 23: St. Tammany Parish Unincorporated Area Water Service Coverage












# Map 29: St. Tammany Parish Watershed Boundaries




# Map 37: St. Tammany Parish Transportation Element Plan Phase 1- Capacity Increases



# Map 39: St. Tammany Parish Transportation Element Plan Phase 1- Master Transportation Corridors





# Map 40: St. Tammany Parish Transportation Element Plan Phase 1 - Rail Improvements





# Map 41: St. Tammany Parish Transportation Element Plan Phase 1- Bicycle Routes








