- 1. Can you confirm that the necessary processing would look as follows:
- Step 1- Process count using class data
- Step 2- Return to basic data, reprocess data using axle/2 scheme (Raw vehicle volume)
- Step 3- Apply axle correction to axel/2 data

2. Will the Traffic Count Adjustment Factor be provided? If not, where can we find the approved method?

Yes, RPC will provide the Adjustment Factors prior to or at the project kickoff. They can also be obtained from LADOTD.

3. We do have technology to collect these counts with video which would provide more accurate data off the bat. This may be unlikely, but is there room for modification in this manner, or are tube counters required?

Video counters may be used and should generally follow the same placement guidelines as tube counters. It is acknowledged that the cameras will be placed on poles and not on the ground.
